

Bassoon Fingering Chart

The chart is organized into six systems, each with a treble clef staff and a bass clef staff. The notes and their corresponding fingering patterns are as follows:

- System 1:** A₄, B₄, B, C, C₄, D₄, D, D₄, E₄, E, F. Includes the note "lowers pitch" for E₄.
- System 2:** F₄, G₄, G, G₄, A₄, A, A₄, B₄, B, C, C₄, D₄.
- System 3:** D, D₄, E₄, E, F, F₄, G₄, G, G₄, A₄. Includes the note "lowers pitch" for E₄ and "lowers pitch" for G₄.
- System 4:** A, A₄, B₄, B, C, C₄, D₄, D.
- System 5:** D₄, E₄, E, F, F₄, G₄, G, G₄, A₄. Includes "for slurs" for E₄ and "for slurs" for E.
- System 6:** A, A₄, B₄, B, C, C₄, D₄, D. Includes "opt 1/2 h" for C₄ and "opt" for D₄. Includes the note "(if D key is available)" for D₄.

(When more than one fingering is shown, the first is the most common.)
