

Oboe Fingering Chart

The chart displays fingering diagrams for the following notes and intervals:

- Row 1: A, B, C, D, E
- Row 2: F, G, A, B
- Row 3: C, D, E, F
- Row 4: F, G, A, B, C
- Row 5: C, D, E, F

Additional notes shown include chromatic alterations: A \sharp , B \flat , C \sharp , D \flat , E \flat , F \sharp , G \flat , A \sharp , B \flat , C \flat , D \sharp , E \sharp .

Special instructions and markings include:

- "use if no resonance key—" (for F)
- "(lowers pitch)" (for A)
- "(harmonic fingering)" (for A)
- "h" (half-hole key)
- "r" (resonance key)

(When more than one fingering is shown, the first is the most common.)
