

This Week in the BRM - For the week of August 23-27, 2021

Tuesday / Thursday band rehearsals continue. Regular season football begins.

Attendance at ALL rehearsals and performances is mandatory.

- Tuesday – Rehearsal @ 6-8:30pm
- Thursday – Rehearsal @ 6-8:30pm
- Friday – Bulldogs at Milton HS (See itinerary below)

As we prepare for our first away game of the season, I wanted to share some important information and policies regarding these trips.

- Students are to report to the band room in travel uniform no later than 3:30pm. Hats and gloves should be carried in the hat box at all times. Plumes and gauntlets will be passed out at the game. Color guard members must be in uniform (warm ups can be worn or brought in a bag).
- Tubas, baritones, trombones, French horns, trumpets and saxophones will be loaded on the truck. Clarinets, flutes and piccolos will be kept on the bus with their owner.
- All color guard and percussion equipment will be loaded on the truck.
- All students must ride the bus on the way to this and any other band event.
- Gum, candy, food and drinks (unless provided by the boosters) are not allowed on the bus.
- **Students should eat before reporting to the band room. A snack will be provided before we leave and after the game.**
- Chaperones are to be considered Mr. Dunn's representatives. Instructions from them must be followed immediately and without question. Any student found to be disrespectful or non-compliant will be brought to Mr. Dunn for disciplinary action.
- During daylight travel hours, students may sit with whomever they choose. However, during nighttime travel, boys and girls and couples will not be allowed to sit together.
- Remain seated and facing forward while the bus is in motion. If seats belts are available, they must be worn while the bus is in motion. No standing, sitting or sleeping in the aisles.
- All electronic devices must be used with earphones so that the user is the only one who can hear it. If you bring electronic devices, you do so at your own risk.
- Keep the bus clean!
- Students will not be allowed to leave before the end of the game.
- **In order for a student to be checked out after the game, the parent or legal guardian must be there in person to sign their student out with the lead chaperone at the bus. A photo ID must be shown. Students will only be dismissed to their parent or legal guardian. No exceptions.**
 - If a student's instrument/equipment is on the truck, he/she must be at the band room when the buses return to unload the instrument/equipment.
- Parents: You may follow the band if you do not know how to get to Milton High School, but **please do not drive between the buses or the buses and the trucks.**
