- Concert Prep Band, Concert Band and Percussion Class students who are not in Symphonic Band or Wind Ensemble will wear band uniforms.
 - Long white socks and white band shoes must be worn
- Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble will wear Concert Dresses and Tuxedos.
 - White T-Shirts must be worn under the tux shirt
 - Black socks and black shoes must be work with the tuxedo
 - Black knee-highs and black shoes must be worn with the concert dress
- The concert concludes with the Wind Ensemble. **Performing band members ARE NOT allowed to leave until after the concert is over!**
