### **BRM Water Bottle Information:**

- Every member of the BRM will be issued a personalized water jug at band camp! It'll have your name and section color sticker on the jug.
- You'll be responsible for bringing your water to all games and taking it home after.
- At home games, you'll bring your jug to the flatbed trailer parked in front of the band room, so they can be taken to the stands.
- At away games, you'll carry your own jug with you from the bus, into the stadium/stands. (Pit will carry battery jugs).
- Please fill with only water and ice. Any carbonation can explode due to shaking while transporting the bottles & make them harder to clean.
- The jugs/stickers aren't dishwasher safe. To clean, put a couple drops of dish soap, some hot water, shake, shake, shake, rinse, all done.
- If you lose or destroy your water bottle, you will need to purchase a new one from us for \$15. Contact Amy Quarrier 850-603-3304 with name and section & we'll get it labeled
- We will collect all the jugs after the last football game. If you need to turn yours in sooner for any reason, please let us know.
